Hall made his start with the San Diego State University Aztecs, where he was a two-time NSCAA All American and a semi-finalist for the M.A.C Hermann Trophy, which is awarded to the nations top college soccer player. Additionally, during his college years, he was a first team all PAC ten conference honoree for 2 consecutive years as well as having played with the Boulder Rapids Reserve in the USL Premier Development League. Hall has also trained with the United States U-23 men's national soccer team. In 2007, Hall was

drafted by the Los Angeles Galaxy for the MLS Super draft but instead decided to sign with the Danish Club Esbjerg. After a 2 year stint, Hall returned to the U.S in 2009 and signed with the Houston Dynamo. Hall made headlines for the Dynamo when he scored a goal during the 2009-2010 CONCACAF Champions League game against Isidro Metapon, which resulted in a shutout earning Hall his MLS debut against DC United.

Terry Boss began his soccer career while attending Philomath high school in Corvallis, Oregon where he was a first team all-state and all-conference selection as a senior. He led the team, Corvallis United, to the Oregon State Cup title. 2000-2004 Boss played for the University of Tulsa, where he started 20 games. He also featured for Cascade Surge, Vermont Voltage and Fort Wayne Fever in the USL Premier Development League. 2005 began his professional

career with the Charlotte Eagles in the USL Second Division. In 2006 Boss moved to the Puerto Rico Islanders in the USL First Division. In 2008 he returned back to Charlotte where he was the starting goalkeeper for a team that finished first place in USL-2. He led USL-2 in 11 wins and 9 shutouts. Boss was named goalkeeper of the year for 2008 by USL-2. 2009 brought Boss to the Seattle Sounders where he made his MLS debut in 2010 in a game against FC Dallas as a second half sub for an injured player.
