## Goalkeeper Tally Hall of the Houston Dynamo signs sponsorship deal with SELLS USA

**Tally Hall of the Houston Dynamo** recently signed a sponsorship and endorsement agreement with SELLS USA to promote the English premier line of goalie gloves and accessories. SELLS goalkeeping products are distributed exclusively by Goal Sporting Goods in the U.S and are worn by 45% of the #1 EPL goalkeepers.

Hall made his start with the San Diego State University Aztecs, where he was a two-time NSCAA All American and a semi-finalist for the M.A.C Hermann Trophy, which is awarded to the nations top college soccer player. Additionally, during his college years, he was a first team all PAC ten conference honoree for two consecutive years as well as having played with the Boulder Rapids Reserve in the USL Premier Development League. Hall has also trained with the United States U-23 men's national soccer team. In 2007, Hall was drafted by the Los Angeles Galaxy for the MLS Super draft but instead decided to sign with the Danish Club Esbjerg. After a two year stint, Hall returned to the U.S in 2009 and signed with the Houston Dynamo. Hall made headlines for the Dynamo when he scored a goal during the 2009-2010 CONCACAF Champions League game against Isidro Metapon. In 2010, Hall made five league appearances as a professional keeper with his MLS debut against DC United, which resulted in a shutout game of 2-0.

2011 marks Hall's collaboration with SELLS USA, where he has quickly proven himself as becoming one of the best goalkeepers in the MLS. Hall ranks third in the league with a 78% goals allowed average, only letting 4 through in the first five games. In April, he was nominated 2 weeks in a row for the MLS save of the week.
